Trip to the Zoo


On February, outstanding boys and girls from different lodginghouses were taken on a trip to the Culiacan Zoo.

During the trip, the Zoo's guides explained to them the story about how and when the zoo was founded, and a brief historical review during the fifties was shared, when the development plan of the government of the Sinaloa state, contemplated the need of creating a natural area that would contribute in the educational foment about the existing wildlife in this region. This plan turned out to be transformed into reality on December 14th of 1958. The main promoter for the Zoo's opening was the state's governor, General Gabriel Leyva Velazquez.

The place where the Zoo was constructed, as well as the Constitutional Civic Center, was previously a mango's farm that belonged to the Redo family. The total area is 16.4 acres, of which the zoo covers 2.5 acres in total.
