



National Health's Week

The National Health's Week began in 1980 and its main objective is to protect the health of children nationwide. The program is based in the application of vaccines that are needed by minors of 5 years old, as well as the vaccines that are administered in a complimentary way to the teenagers and adults.

The Sabin vaccine is applied to all minors of 5 years old to prevent poliomyelitis. In the case of babies younger than 1 year old, they also get booster shots anti rotavirus, anti pneumococcus, pentavalent, BCG and hepatitis B. This vaccination campaign is so important that we try to make people aware of the benefits so they can come voluntarily with their children to get the needed shots.
